Safeguarding Children and Young People with Disabilities

Outline

The protection of disabled children presents a great challenge for professional carers and families to work effectively together to provide appropriate safety from abuse. The course provides an overview of abuse and the opportunity to review good practice. This course will raise awareness of key issues linked to children and young people with disabilities and potential behaviours and the vulnerabilities professionals should be aware of and when that increases risk.
