Human Trafficking Training for staff working in Educational Settings

Course Outline

The training sessions recognise that any member of staff may come across victims of modern slavery or human trafficking in their day to day work. Many of us will have little or limited knowledge and understanding of slavery or trafficking, how to recognise the signs or what to do if they suspect that someone is a victim. This lack of awareness and understanding could result in a failure to recognise potential victims, leaving them unsupported or protected against the traffickers and gang masters. The opportunity to bring the perpetrators of this horrendous crime to justice could also be missed.

Aim of the Training

To provide attendees with the necessary understanding and knowledge to identify and respond appropriately to support and protect potential victims of modern slavery and human trafficking.

Content of the Training

- The indicators of a Potential Victim of Modern Slavery or Human Trafficking
- An understanding of the types of exploitation
- A brief outline of the legislation associated with trafficking
- An overview of the National Referral Mechanism
- How to report concerns
- A local prospective around Operation Anglestoke
