

Camp Over Saturday 30th June

Farsley Farfield PTA's Summer Camp-Over is back again by popular demand for a fifth year! Great weather has been booked again. Families can attend on a day ticket or bring a tent or caravan: last year we had nearly 500 people on site and 70 camping families!



This year we have lined up the 200ft inflatable assault course again where we will be organising another family competition - let's see if the winners from last year will regain their title! New this year will be donkey rides, Nerf Gun Wars, Inflatable football pool, Zorbs, balloon modelling, bingo and a singing duo. As well as all this, we have favourites from previous years: an on-going water fight, tug of war, face painting, bouncy castle, den-making, camp fire, sports and more...



Most importantly, the day is about families and children relaxing and playing together: we don't provide minute by minute entertainment but everyone has fun. There will be two last 16 World Cup matches on 30th June (not England) and these can be shown inside if there is demand.

The afternoon food will be 'bring your own picnic'. We tried this a couple of years ago and it proved very popular. Tables will be available on the junior yard so families can eat together if you wish. (Please note no BBQ's on to the school grounds). There will be a small tuck shop throughout the day as we will be selling some picnic style food but amounts will be restricted.

As usual, chilli/curry (with vegetarian options) or hot meat sandwiches will be available in the early evening (hot dogs for children). There will be a licensed bar. Families will also be invited to provide home-baked produce for a cake stall. On Sunday morning, the school kitchen staff are laying on a full cooked breakfast (additional charge): letter to follow shortly.
