

Thematic Learning from Safeguarding Reviews Practitioners Learning Event

Domestic violence and abuse is a major challenge for the city. In the last two years, four reviews have been completed involving the death or serious injury of 4 adults and 4 children which have involved domestic abuse and violence. This session brings together the learning from those reviews so that themes can be explored.

These free sessions will involve sharing an overview of the reviews and exploring with colleagues the key themes that have emerged. Through a mixture of case studies and group work, participants will reflect on the cases and identify ways that their own practice can be improved in light of the learning.

The session will be led by the Safer Leeds Domestic Violence Team, and the Leeds Safeguarding Children Partnership.
