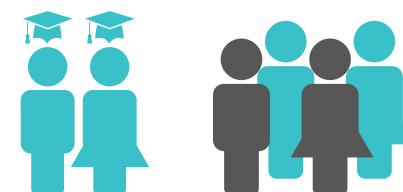

Final



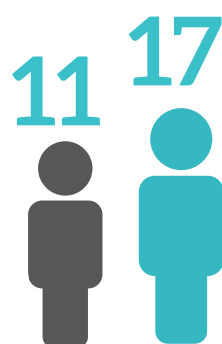
The highest scoring entrants will be invited to an exciting day of cyber activities at York Race Course on 6th July 2019. Parents and teachers, we have activities for you too!
