## Competition 1 - Perform with confidence- Poetry

We had such a great response to our read aloud competition last year (140 entries) and loved seeing the children read aloud with such confidence. This year, we would like children to send in a video recording of themselves performing a poem.

The recording should be no longer than 2 minutes (and will typically be much less). We will be looking for children reading clearly, with good pace and expression. Think about how you can make it interesting and engaging for the listener. You will need to practise and refine your performance - this is unlikely to be a 'one take' clip, especially for older pupils. We will choose a winner from each class and celebrate everyone's entries. Phones or <u>Chromebooks</u> can be used to create the recordings.

Your entry could be a simple recording or you could embellish it with costumes, props or backgrounds. Please submit videos by the end of Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March. Upload the video or audio recording by using this form. Please note: we are likely to publish some of these recordings online so please let us know if you don't want us to do so.

## **Competition 2 - Character fanfiction**
