Club allocations will be completed once the form has closed and **you will receive an email informing you if your child has a place in their chosen clubs by Wednesday 20th September**. This will include all details for the club, including start and finish dates and times, cost for the term and any other relevant information. Unless otherwise stated, clubs will begin w/c 25th September and run up to 15th December.

Many of our clubs are often very oversubscribed. Where this is the case, children will be placed onto a waiting list. Extra-curricular club options for term 2 (January-March) will be sent home nearer the time and priority will be given to children who may have been on waiting lists in term 1.
