

Farsley Farfield Primary School Annual Parent Survey 2025


We carried out a survey of parents in July 2025. We got 184 responses: a good rate of return and slightly up on last year. This short summary document reports back on some of the key questions in the survey. Staff and governors will look at responses in more detail. Key feedback:

Happiness

97.8% of children were quite or very happy last year, with three quarters being 'very happy'.

Q6. Generally, how happy has your child been in school this year? 184 responses




Behaviour

Children's behaviour at Farfield is usually very good. Most families agree.

Q7. From what you see or hear, how highly would you rate the general behaviour of children in your child's class?



Bullying


A very large majority of children never experienced what might be felt was bullying. Most parents whose children reported that bullying had been an issue, reported the school's response as being good or excellent.

Q9. Has your child been the victim of bullying this academic year? Bullying would be classed as targeted and repeated behaviour that hurts someo...ing rumours, threatening or undermining someone. 184 responses




Special Educational Needs

A new question this year related to provision for children with Special Educational Needs. Feedback was typically very good, The only 'Not at all well' response related to a child who isn't currently on the SEND register. More investigation is needed here.



Educational Progress

From their many and varied starting points, children almost always progress well academically at Farfield. 98% of parents were pleased with their children's progress in 24-5, and over two thirds were very pleased.




Q17. How pleased are you with the educational progress of your child? 184 responses

Overall Experience

Over 80% of parents regarded their children's overall experience at Farfield as 'Excellent' and over 98% regarded it as good or better.
