


Show Time is a wonderful chance for our children in Years 5 and 6 to enjoy a wide range of shows at local theatres over the course of a year. We hope that this is culturally enriching, thought-provoking and great entertainment..

We will have 55 children's tickets for each show. Children must commit to all shows: they can't be 'cherry-picked'. We have selected a range of different shows and genres, including musicals, a Christmas classic and a play based on a Y4 class text. (There are only 4 shows this year as we couldn't get sufficiently good value prices for a couple shows at Leeds Grand.)

Children travel in school minibuses (and sometimes staff or parent cars) and are supervised by school staff. We meet in the Pudsey Civic Hall car park at the start and end of each evening performance. **Cost: £60 (free for children in receipt of Pupil Premium)**. We appreciate that this is a lot of money but it is also very good value for four high quality shows including transport. Payments will be made via Parent Pay (but do not attempt to do this until the place is confirmed by email). Payment can be made in instalments.



Frequently Asked Questions about Show Time

What do pupils wear? Pupils wear school uniform for each show.

Can children bring sweets? No. If they wish, they can bring a water bottle but it must not be a noisy one!

Can the children have an ice cream at the interval? Yes, we will email you about this before each show. These are not included in the £60.

What are the timings? These vary show by show, venue by venue. We typically collect and drop off at Pudsey Civic Hall car park at 6ish and 10.30ish. Exact timings are announced prior to each show. We run a Show Time Whats App group for updates and reminders.
