This will include all details for the club, including start and finish dates and times, cost for the term and any other relevant information. Unless otherwise stated, clubs will begin w/c 12th January and run up to 27th March. There will be no clubs in the final week of term before the Easter holidays, due to Parents' Evenings.

Once allocations are completed, the cost of the club will be added to your ParentPay account and this **must be paid for before the club begins**. Clubs will be free for children in receipt of free school meals, adopted or Children Looked After by the local authority.

Many of our clubs are often very oversubscribed. Where this is the case, children will be placed onto a waiting list and places offered if/when they become available.
