Welcome back!

We would like to wish a warm welcome to all children and parents joining Year 6 this year.

We hope you find the information in this newsletter useful.

Homework

In Year 6, the children will receive weekly spelling homework set through Spelling Shed. Until October, they will also receive weekly maths homework set through Mathletics or TT Rockstars.

From October, the children will receive a study guide and book for both English and Maths and will be expected to complete a page (or 2) from both books each week. Homework will be set on Friday and should be back in school for the following Thursday.

Extreme Reading

Each week, an 'Extreme Reading' competition is held between the classes in Key Stage 2. This results in the award of a highly coveted weekly trophy and class reward. The classes compete to be the one with the highest percentage of children completing a reading activity every night of the week, Monday to Thursday, and once over the weekend. In order to achieve 100%, each member of the class must read for at least 10 minutes each night **and** have their planner signed. If you support your child in reading, we would love for you to sign their planner. If they read independently, we are happy for them to sign it each day, detailing the book they're reading and page numbers. Please would you encourage your child to read each night and sign their diary in order for them to achieve 100% each week?

PE

The Y6 children will do PE every **Tuesday**. Please ensure children come to school wearing their PE kit on that day. They will need suitable indoor and outdoor footwear and warmer clothing (jogging bottoms and jumper/hoodie) for outdoor PE, especially in the winter months as we still go out and do PE in all weather.

Indoor Shoes

Please could we ask that you make sure your child has a pair of indoor shoes to wear. As the weather gets worse we do still try to go outside as much as possible, and changing shoes is then essential. Children will be asked to come into class in their socks if they do not have a pair of indoor shoes.

School Trips

This year, we hope to enhance our curriculum with a variety of exciting themed days and educational visits. We are intending to plan some new trips for Year 6 this year but as these have not yet been finalised we will confirm the details separately at a later date.

In the Autumn term, we hope to visit the Royal Armouries in relation to our WW1 topic. We expect the trip to cost approximately £5 per child. Dates and further information to follow. We hope to organise a trip to a local Gurdwara linked to our RE topic. This will be free of charge though donation to the Gurdwara will be welcomed.

In the Summer term, we will be visiting Leeds Industrial Museum as part of our topic on the Industrial Revolution. We expect this to cost approximately £5 per child. We are also hoping to have a guest speaker who will discuss the role Titus Salt played in the Industrial Revolution, this will cost approximately £4.

We are in the process of booking our Year 6 residential to How Stean Gorge for summer 2027. Both classes will attend at separate points during the week. We expect the cost to be approximately £250 and we will send out a separate letter with more information on this very soon.

Further details of trips and costs will be sent nearer to the time. We are lucky at Farfield that our visits cost so little as we are often able to use our own transport or get free or cheap train tickets. These requests to cover costs are voluntary contributions. We hope that advance notice will help with budgeting.
